Sujatha and I are very excited about our new home that was recently completed. During our 22 years of marriage, Sujatha and I had to move our family many times. Our children always wanted a permanent home where they would have the freedom to play and where we could live without an abundance of restrictions from the landlords. They always wanted a house so that we didn't have to move every time our neighbours or our landlord became upset with us because of our faith or the GBBM ministry. If I have any regrets regarding our children, it is that we couldn't give them a place they could call their home. BUT today the home we built was largely financed with the help of their insurance money. Of course, we praise God because we know they are currently living in their eternal home! We thank all the churches and families who extended their support in helping us complete our home.

Christian persecution in India continues to increase but our Gospel work has not changed. GBBM CPPs and believers are making use of every possible opportunity to present the Gospel to the Banjara people. Birthday celebrations, wedding anniversaries, funerals and burial services are being used to share the love, joy, and peace available through a relationship with Jesus.

We praise the Lord for July's results as the GBBM team: shared the Gospel with 6,817 people, hosted 3,662 children in programs, rejoiced as 215 people accepted Jesus, and 14 people were baptized. Training next level leaders is in progress.

Aletheia Banjara School is running smoothly with 418 students enrolled. The students recently finished their first Formative Assessment Tests.

Thank you for joining hands with us as we share the Good News with the lost Banjara people in the remote villages of India.
