Dear Brethren in Christ, greetings from India!

The people of India are currently experiencing two major events, scorching temperatures, and friction from government elections. All church members are actively praying that the current governing party will be voted out of office. GBBM believes that the Lord of lords and the King of kings is on His throne (Psalm 103:19) and it doesn't matter who sits in the seat of the Prime Minister of India because ultimately the Lord has sovereignty over all things and all people.

Each month, I try not to bring up the Christian persecution in India, but it is an ongoing reality. Pastors and evangelists are attacked, arrested, and often denied bail for months. The persecution has made ministering to children and sharing the Gospel in new villages very challenging for our leaders. The GBBM Church Planting Pastors (CPPs) are stopped, questioned, and often threatened in new unreached villages.

It is encouraging to see CPPs persistence and commitment as they serve the people in the villages where they minister. Seven new villages were visited this quarter.

We praise God for the March ministry results. The GBBM team shared the Gospel with 7,667 people, hosted 1,309 children in programs, rejoiced as 277 people accepted Jesus, and 22 people were baptized. We give God the glory for guiding the CPPs during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2024: 22,346 people heard the Gospel; 724 accepted Jesus as their saviour; 66 people were baptised, and three new churches were planted.

GBBM will host VBS events to reach children this summer. Please pray that the Lord protects our CPPs and volunteers and opens the ears, eyes, and hearts of the children to accept His Good News.

Aletheia Banjara School is closed for summer vacation till June 11<sup>th</sup>. We praise God for the two former teachers who are re-joining ABS in June 2024.

### Special Occasions like Palm Sunday, the Crucifixion, and Resurrection:

The Lord allowed the GBBM CPPs to encourage believers with the word and to witness to non-believers during Palm Sunday. On Palm Sunday, GBBM believers visited their local villages and towns singing songs about Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This event gives non-Christians the opportunity to ask questions and hear about Jesus. Believers from all GBBM house churches and our CPPs gathered for Good Friday services and to meditate on the crucifixion and the last words spoken by

Jesus on the Cross. Believers gathered on a nearby hilly place before sunrise to worship the Son who rose from the dead. New believers get excited to take part in the services and GBBM CPPs put all their efforts to make these events memorable and spiritually enhancing. We thank God for the freedom He has us given to conduct



these meetings.

**Softening Prashanth's Father:** GBBM loves to see men, especially fathers, saved so they can lead their families in the path of the Lord. Due to hostility and cultural issues, Banjara men are typically more difficult to reach than younger people and women. The youth are often more open to listening to the Good News. During GBBM's history we have witnessed 100's of children between 10-15 years old come



to Christ and then lead their parents and family members to know the Lord. God

saving Prashanth's father Poonya Naik is one example. Prashanth came to Christ in 2013 as early teenager. His family opposed his Christianity and gave him hard time.

Prashanth started praying for the salvation of his family members. After several years of prayers, Prashanth's younger sister came to Christ. For many years Poonya Naik showed his bitterness toward Pastor Laxman and his children. Recently Poonya began to experience ongoing heart pain. In 2021 she was killed in a vehicle accident; and sadly, a few months ago their





mother also passed away during a road accident; both are with the Lord. The two







teenage boys are now orphans.

The

boys have no assets nor any income source. Pray that the Lord may pour His Grace upon them and show His way to these young men. GBBM is doing its best to meet their immediate needs and provide them with spiritual nurturing. They want to go to college. Their story is very tragic, but they both know Jesus.
