Dear Brethren in Christ, greetings from India!

The month of June begins the sowing and planting season for the majority of Banjara people (most work as farmers or farm labor). GBBM Church Planting Pastors (CPPs) and other GBBM leaders take advantage of this time and try to sow and plant seeds among the people working in the fields. Our CPPs find that the farmers may be willing to take a break for a conversation during this season. Please pray for ears to hear and for the Lord to bless our efforts.

We praise God for the ministry results during the month of June 2024. The GBBM team shared the Gospel with 8,027 people, rejoiced as 383 people accepted Jesus, and 10 people were baptized. The 2024 second quarter ministry results clearly show that God is working among the Banjara people. We praise God for His goodness, for His abundant love and for His many answered prayers as 24,699 people heard the Gospel, 1,182 prayed to accept Jesus as their personal saviour; and 48 believers witnessed in water baptism.

Aletheia Banjara School started its 16th school year this June. ABS is blessed to have 18 loving and caring teachers, a dedicated support staff and a trusted leader as our principal. ABS receives no government funding and relies on the donations of our wonderful partners to support this Christian school that servers as a shining light in the lives of our students and the surrounding villages. The school has multiple financial needs that can be met through the sponsorship of our students or donations. Please pray that the Lord provides for our needs based on His timing and His schedule and according to His will. during his treatment. During visits to the various temples, etc., they happened to visit a GBBM Church for prayer. Ashwathappa's mother told CPP Solomon Naik that if





Jesus heals my son from his cancer, my son and his wife will believe in Jesus. Pastor and Church prayed for this young man's healing. In their next visit doctors confirmed that the tumour was non-cancerous. The family believed that only Jesus performed this healing and started attending the GBBM Church. Ashwathappa and his wife Ramanujamma both accepted Jesus and witnessed in baptism that Jesus not only helped with physical healing, but now believe Jesus is the Son of God and that Jesus died for their sins and rose from the dead to give them everlasting life as they place their faith in Him.

PRAY TO GOD FOR PRASHATH:

Prashanth accidentally fell from a roof and broke his back. He cannot walk without



assistance. He has been listening to the Word of God for several months and understands the Gospel. According to CPP Sakram, he is seeking physical healing before he commits his life to Jesus. CPP Sakram regularly visits and encourages him. Both of his parents have

passed away and his stepbrothers live in another town. Please pray that the Lord may show His mercies upon Prashanth to save and heal him.
